

The StudioWare "XG-Chord" is an easy way to insert chord-events into MIDI-files with the sequencer-program Cakewalk or Sonar. The chord-notations are displayed on the screen of YAMAHA keyboards.

A short introduction:

1. Open a Cakewalk or Sonar project.
2. Open the file "XG-Chord.CakewalkStudioWare" of the StudioWare XG-Chord.
3. Click on "Spur-Auswahl" with the right mouse-button to select a non-empty MIDI-channel.
4. With "Takt" (> or <) select the measure and with "Beat" (> or <) the beat.
5. Select the base of the chord with "Grundton".
6. On the rightside select the type of the chord.
7. Use "Snapshot" to insert the chord-event.

Repeat steps 4 - 7 for all chords you want.
